#### Dear friends,

From this Sunday, there is a decided change in our Lenten journey. From now on we focus much more on the coming events of the Passion of Jesus: his entry into Jerusalem, his last week with his disciples, his Last Supper, and his way of the cross and death Good Friday. Prior the 1960s, this two week period was known as "Passiontide" with two separate Sundays: Palm Sunday and Passion Sunday (These are now combined as Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord).

How has your Lent been? Are you ready to walk with Jesus in these final two weeks of Lent? Most of us have probably made some progress in our spiritual journey this Lent: most of us could probably do a bit more. It is not too late. If you cando nothing else, how about reading the Passion according to Luke as part of your prayer (Luke 22:14-23:56). Let us make this journey to the Cross of Christ and really open ourselves to the triumph of God's great love of which we will sing at Easter.

## PALM SUNDAY


# The Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord is on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April.


