

READINGS FOR THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

This week we have the readings for next Sunday the 12th of June for Parishioners to make some time during the week to read and reflect on.

FIRST READING | Proverbs 8:22-31

The Wisdom of God cries aloud:

The Lord created me when his purpose first unfolded, before the oldest of his works.

From everlasting I was firmly set,

from the beginning, before earth came into being.

The deep was not, when I was born,

there were no springs to gush with water.

Before the mountains were settled,

before the hills, I came to birth;

before he made the earth, the countryside,

or the first grains of the world's dust.

When he fixed the heavens firm, I was there, when he drew a ring on the surface of the deep,
